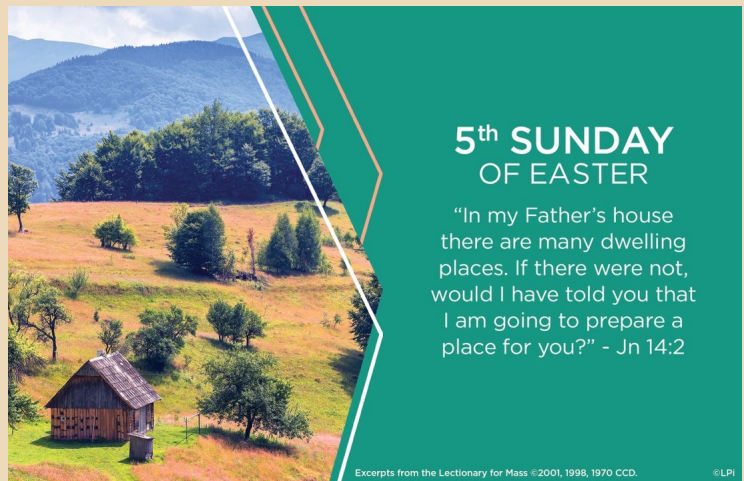

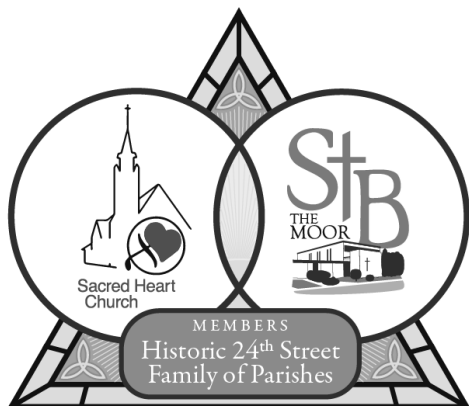

Update on the SBTM Capital Improvement Campaign

As you know, we started the Capital Improvement Campaign at the beginning of this year to raise \$321,750 for major improvements to the building (the Elevator, Windows, HVAC, Fire/alarm) We received a grant in the amount of \$200,000. We've also received donations totaling \$35,510. But we are still a long way off. Please pray and look into your hearts to see what amount you can give to this much needed project. 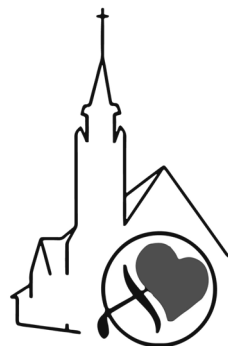
